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No. 5 of the February 2 Order, Sabal Trail also requests approval to modify and reduce the workspace at this location to comply with the Georgia stream buffer crossing requirements.

Sabal Trail provides in Attachment A summary information on each of these areas, including a description of the existing land use/cover type. Alignment sheets and mapping identifying the areas that are the subject of these requests are included as Attachment B. Additionally, Sabal Trail submits in Attachment C, all applicable environmental clearances for the modifications requested herein. Sabal Trail also confirms it has obtained the necessary landowner approvals, and no sensitive resources will be affected. All other information required to commence construction at the locations requested herein was included in Sabal Trail's Initial Implementation Plan filed on March 11, 2016, as supplemented.<sup>3</sup>

Sabal Trail hereby requests that the Director of OEP issue approval on or before October 20, 2016 to proceed with construction at these locations.
