<u>Minimum setback from any property line for a coop</u>	<u>Fifteen (15) feet Shall be located in the rear yard only</u>
<u>Minimum setback from any property line for the outdoor fenced enclosure</u>	<u>Fifteen (15) feet Shall be located in the rear yard only</u>
<u>Sanitation</u>	<u>Odor and pest control required Coop and outdoor fenced enclosure must be cleaned on a regular basis to prevent the accumulation of waste.</u>
