SHOCK

A state of inadequate tissue perfusion.

Provide supplemental oxygen per oxygen therapy protocol

RAPID TRAUMA
ASSESSMENT

• Head
• Neck
• Chest
• Abdomen

Restlessness
Anxiety
Progressive lethargy
Cool, clammy and pale
skin
Peripheral cyanosis
Excessive thirst
Nausea / Vomiting
Rapid shallow
respirations
Rapid, weak and/or
absent peripheral pulses
Dilated pupils
Decreased LOC
Low B/P

IMMEDIATELY arrange for EMS transport

Pelvis Extremities

Obtain baseline vitals.

Perform detailed physical exam and history

Attempt to determine/isolate cause of symptoms

Monitor vitals every 5 minutes until patient is transported by EMS
