OROPHARYNGEAL AIRWAY

Can be used on obtunded patients with spontaneous respirations without an intact gag reflex.

Pre-oxygenate patient if possible	
Measure airway from corner of mouth to the earlobe	
Insert the airway inverted and rotate 180 degrees into place	
A tongue depressor may be used to assist with insertion of airway.	
Ventilate patient and auscultate for lung sounds
