Rezoning Case REZ-2019-13 NATCO, Val Del Rd. R-1 to P-D, County Water & Sewer, ~56.102 acres

Planning Representative, Molly Stevenson, presented the item. Mrs. Stevenson stated the applicant is requesting to rezone so that the property can be developed for residential purposes. Mrs. Stevenson further stated the development will connect to county water and sewer. Mrs. Stevenson mentioned that several citizens spoke against the request at the Planning Commission meeting with complaints related to increased traffic and wetland encroachment. Mrs. Stevenson added that the Planning Commission voted in favor of the rezoning and the TRC had no objections.

Rezoning Case REZ-2019-14 Wisenbaker Property, 3820 Great North Rd. E-A to R-1, County Well/Septic, ~5.0 acres

Planning Representative, Molly Stevenson, presented the item. Mrs. Stevenson stated the applicant would like to rezone one acre for residential use and add the other four acres to an existing agricultural tract. Mrs. Stevenson further stated the Planning Commission recommended approval and the TRC had no objectionable comments.

Rezoning Case REZ-2019-15 Hogan Property, US Hwy 41 N. & Wellman PI. E-A/R-1/M-1 to M-2, Well & Septic, ~7.01 acres

Chairman Slaughter introduced the item and informed the Commission that staff received a letter from the applicant requesting the item be tabled.

REPORTS - County Manager
