

county. Mrs. Quarterman emphasized the importance of understanding these challenges and encouraged the commission to keep the public informed on water-related issues.

Keyara Hamilton, 1000 North St. Augustine Road, addressed the commission regarding Goodwill Industries Southern Rivers, a private non-profit social enterprise, serving over fifty counties in Georgia and Alabama. She highlighted their mission of "changing lives through the power of work" and detailed the free services they provide, including job fairs onsite and offsite, interviewing, training, career coaches, resume writing and job searching for individuals aged 14 and older. Commissioner Wisenbaker asked if this office was located by Hobby Lobby, Ms. Hamilton answered yes.
