

Laura Hannah Dixon, 303 Tomlinson Drive, addressed the commission in opposition to data centers. Ms. Dixon stated that selecting an alternative location could also impact wildlife and surrounding areas. She further recommended that a representative from the community be selected to participate in meetings related to the project.

Chairman Slaughter stated that a press release outlining the position of Lowndes County is available on the County's website and social media platforms. Vice Chairman Orenstein stated that the Board is unified on this matter and encouraged citizens to contact him or any other commissioner with questions or concerns. He further noted that research is being conducted by consulting with other communities and colleagues across the state.
