

- ❖ Lowndes County and the Cities should **consider planting flora that “drinks” water during beautification and greenspace projects.**
- ❖ Lowndes County and the Cities should **collaborate with local outdoor groups, such as WWALS, to market and promote local outdoor events and cleanups.**
- ❖ Both Boards of Education should **require that students attend field trips to local natural areas as part of science and/or history curriculums.**
- ❖ Relevant stakeholders should **use One Mile Branch (and other suitable waterways) for recreation, stormwater management, and ecosystem preservation.**

Funding opportunities that should be considered

- ❖ **Clean Water State Revolving Fund (GEFA)** (water quality, stormwater management, watershed protection projects)
- ❖ **DNR** (land conservation, habitat restoration, environmental education)
- ❖ **GOSP** (conservation, greenspace acquisition, outdoor recreation facilities)
- ❖ **LWCF** (land acquisition, development, and rehabilitation)
