

# Water Consumption & Discharge

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Lowndes County's ordinance will require a "Closed Loop" system.

- ❖ Closed Loop systems do not discharge into a waste water system. They work similar to a car's radiator by recirculating water or a water/glycol mixture after an initial fill. Glycol is not a forever chemical.
- ❖ The initial fill can be required by ordinance to be brought in outside of Lowndes County's aquifer.
- ❖ Any wastewater/discharge for maintenance can be required by ordinance to be collected and disposed of outside of Lowndes County.
- ❖ Water consumption for data centers using closed loop systems can be no more than that of "normal office" and landscape irrigation activities.
