Sabal Trail Transmission, LLC ("Sabal Trail") is an interstate natural gas transmission company that has maintained and safely operated interstate pipelines through Alabama, Georgia, and Florida since 2017. Sabal Trail constructs, maintains, and operates interstate natural gas transmission pipelines under the jurisdiction of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") pursuant to the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C. §§ 717-717w).

Sabal Trail is currently evaluating a potential expansion and extension of its interstate natural gas pipeline system in your area as part of a new project called the Sabal Trail Extension and Sabal Trail Expansion (the "Project"). The primary objectives of this Project are to: meet growing energy demand driven by population growth and economic development in the regions served by Sabal Trail; provide firm transportation service to new customers seeking affordable and reliable natural gas supply; and enhance overall system flexibility and reliability for existing customers while continuing to deliver an essential low-emission energy source that supports energy affordability, grid stability and economic growth.

The scope of the Sabal Trail Expansion portion of the Project may include:

- An expansion of the existing pipeline from Alexander City, Alabama to Reunion, Florida by constructing a new pipeline generally alongside or near to the existing pipeline route for a distance of approximately 482 miles
- Upgrades to the existing compressor stations in:
 - Alexander City, Alabama
 - Albany, Georgia
 - Hildreth, Dunnellon and Reunion, Florida
- A new Compressor Station (proposed Fort Mitchell Compressor Station) in Russell County, Alabama

The scope of the Sabal Trail Extension portion of the Project may include:

- An extension of our existing pipeline from Alexander City, Alabama westward for roughly 306 miles to connect to other existing interstate natural gas transmission pipelines in Mississippi. This extension would enable Sabal Trail to efficiently deliver natural gas to potential new customers along the pipeline route in Alabama
- Two new compressor stations (one each in Alabama and Mississippi at locations yet to be determined)

Attached is a Project fact sheet which includes maps of the proposed Project areas for Sabal Trail Expansion and Sabal Trail Extension. The purpose of this letter is to introduce the proposed Project to you and explain our next steps. To help us refine the scope of the Project, company representatives are beginning to collect and evaluate information to determine a design that will minimize overall landowner, community and environmental impact, while balancing constructability concerns. You are receiving this letter because your property is within or near the study corridor that is being considered for the above Project scope. In a separate letter to follow, company representatives will be requesting permission to access your property for survey work and to evaluate the extent of any environmental and cultural resources within the study corridor for the Project.

We are also beginning to update community leaders and elected officials about the Project. In addition, we will soon be meeting with other stakeholders, including landowners and government agencies to discuss the Project and to seek input on proposed routing for the new pipeline facilities. Landowner information meetings will be scheduled in the coming months, as more details are known. You will receive notice of the times, dates, and locations of the landowner information meetings once they are determined.

Please be assured that we are very early in the proposed Project process and you will have multiple opportunities to interact and engage with the Project team as well as participate in the appropriate regulatory processes. It is our goal to communicate early and often about our Project activities in order to build positive relationships with all those affected. If approved by FERC, construction of the Project is anticipated to begin in 2029.

This notification requires no further action from you at this time. Proposed Sabal Trail Transmission Expansion and Extension Development



Sabal Trail Transmission, LLC (“Sabal Trail”) is in the early assessment stage of further developing its existing interstate natural gas pipeline system in the Southeast. This proposed project is intended to increase and diversify transportation capacity to reliably deliver natural gas to power-generating companies, local distribution companies and other end users.

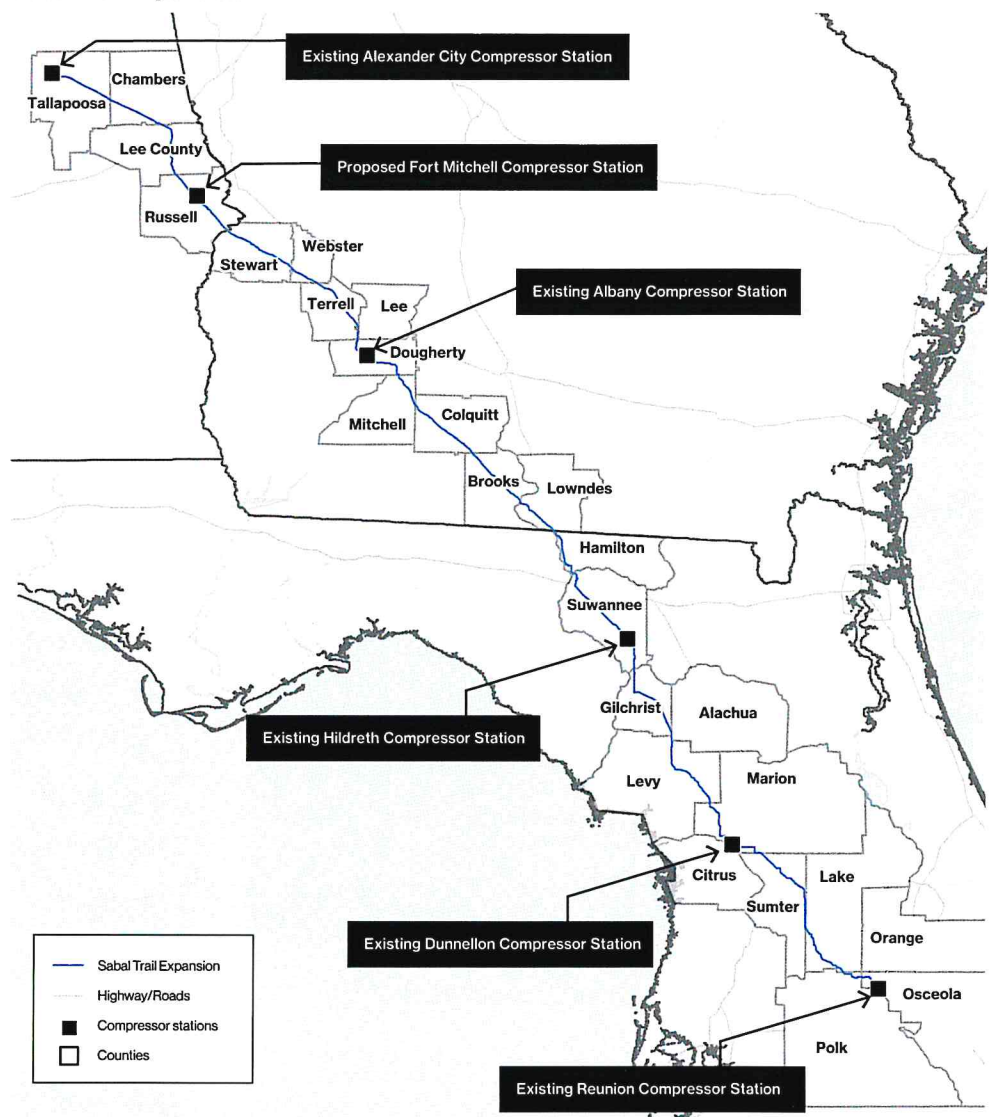
Project overview

The proposed project consists of two major segments*:

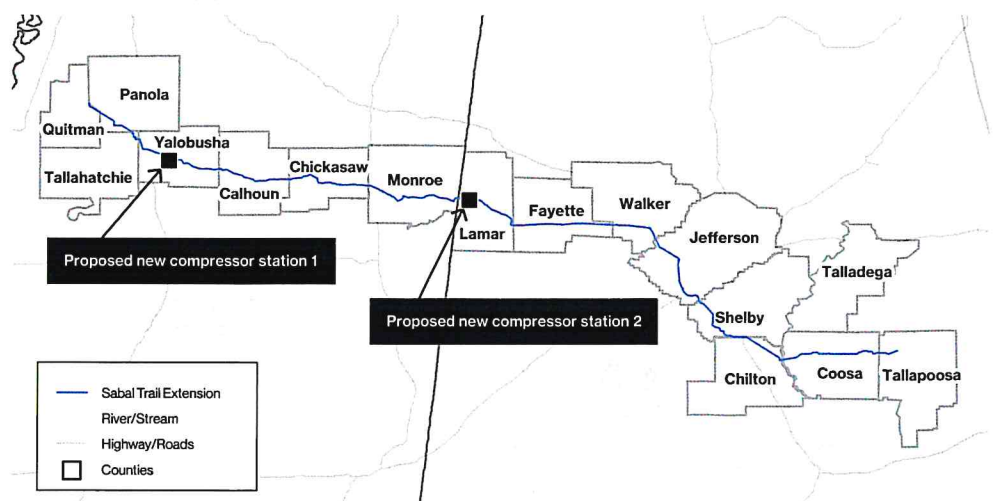
- An “**Expansion**” of the existing pipeline from Alexander City, AL to Reunion, FL installing additional horsepower at new and existing compressor station facilities and constructing new pipeline along or near the existing pipeline route.
- An “**Extension**” of the existing Sabal Trail pipeline from Alexander City, AL moving westward to connect with existing major pipelines in Mississippi. This Extension would also enable the efficient delivery of natural gas to potential customers along the pipeline route in Alabama.

* Ultimately, the full scope of the project will be finalized once all customer commitments are received.

Additional details, including preliminary route maps and anticipated project timelines, will be shared on our project website and made available at public meetings in the coming months.



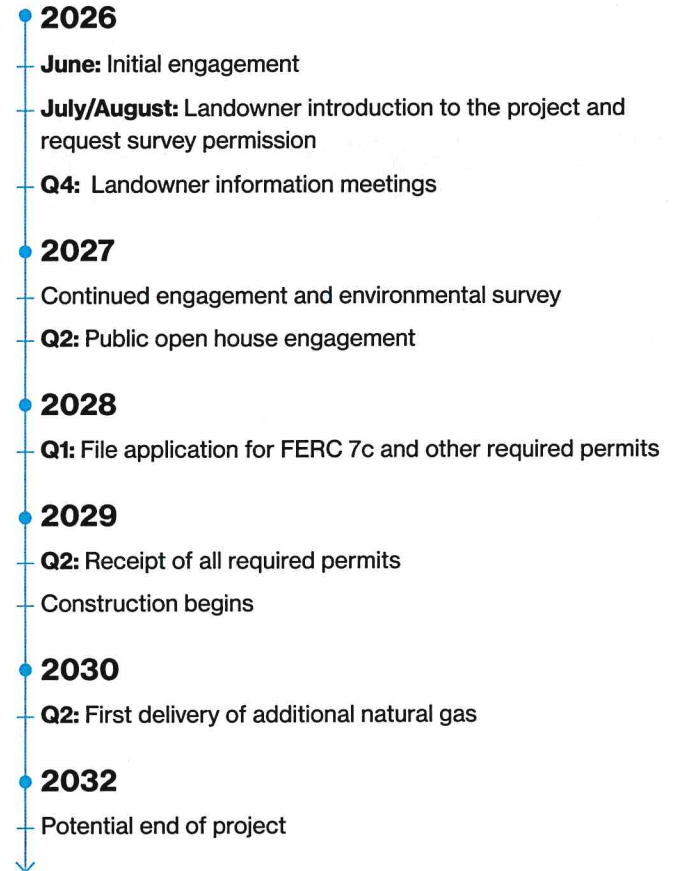
Our commitment to safety and community engagement

Throughout this process, there will be numerous opportunities for the public to participate, review information and provide their input. Once all approvals are received, we plan to start construction in the second quarter of 2029.
