2026 Local Maintenance and Improvements Grant (LMIG) Local Road Assistance (LRA) Resurfacing Bids

Director of Engineering Services, Chad McLeod, presented the item. Mr. McLeod stated the 2026 Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant (LMIG) Local Road Assistance (LRA) application was approved by the Commission on May 12, 2026. The grant was approved by the Georgia Department of Transportation, Lowndes County received the grant funds, and staff advertised the project for bids. The 2026 LMIG LRA Resurfacing bids presented are to include resurfacing the roads attached in the agenda packet. Bids were opened on July 30, 2026, and staff received two bids, the Scruggs Company in the amount of \$1,808,850.75 and Reames and Son Construction in the amount of \$1,829,678.40.

REPORTS - County Manager

David Crawford - Partnership Health Center (Work Session)
