3. Public Hearings

- a) Consideration of an Ordinance for a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to allow the placement of a Mobile Home in a Single-Family Residential (R-6) Zoning District as requested by Mary Pierce (File No. CU-2025-09). The property is located at 809-1/2 Nardo Street. The Planning Commission reviewed this at their November 24, 2025 Regular Meeting and recommended approval subject to four conditions (5-1-1 Vote).
- b) Consideration of an Ordinance to rezone a total of 45.64 acres from Single-Family Residential (R-15) and Residential-Professional (R-P) to Highway-Commercial (C-H) as requested by Atlanta Gas Light (File No. VA-2025-13). The property is located at the northwest corner of Inner Perimeter Road and East Hill Avenue. The Planning Commission reviewed this at their November 24, 2025 Regular Meeting and recommended approval (7-0 Vote).
- c) Consideration of an Ordinance to rezone 0.26 acres from Duplex Residential (DR-10) to Residential-Professional (R-P) as requested by Clarissa Alderman (File No. VA-2025-16).
