Zoning & Land Use History:	This property was originally developed in unincorporated Lowndes County as a concrete pipe manufacturing facility (Miller Concrete Pipe Co.) in the 1950's and it operated for more than 50 years. When the County adopted zoning in 1972, it was given Agricultural (A-U) zoning to match the agricultural-related uses of the area. This zoning remained up until it was annexed into the City as part of the "Islands Annexation" in 2006, whereby it was given E-R zoning (as the City's closest counterpart to the County's A-U zoning). By this time, the concrete manufacturing business had ceased operations but there is still a significant amount of concrete pipe stockpiled on the property.
